IV. Fear

"And do not fear those who kill the body, but are unable to kill the soul; but rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell" (Matthew 10:28).

V. Gratitude

"Therefore, since we receive a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us show gratitude, by which we may offer to God an acceptable service with reverence and awe" (Hebrews 12:28).

VI. Example

"Brethren, join in following my example, and observe those who walk according to the pattern you have in us" (Philippians 3:17).

"Let no one look down on your youthfulness, but [rather] in speech, conduct, love, faith [and] purity, show yourself an example of those who believe" (I Timothy 4:12).
